The Government of the Republic of Tajikistan has received financing from the World Bank in the amount of \$ 50 million toward the cost of the “Tajikistan Preparedness and Resilience to Disasters Project (PREPARED)”.

The Ministry of Transport of the Republic of Tajikistan (hereinafter MoT RT) with the assistance of the Project Implementation Group (hereinafter PIG) will be responsible for the implementation of Component 1 (**Building Road Resilience**) of the PREPARED Project. The objectives of Component 1 include Subcomponent 1.1 Rehabilitation of roads damaged by the 2021 floods and Subcomponent 1.2. Protection and reinforcement of priority roads will aim to ensure that critical infrastructure is resilient to natural disasters.

The MoT RT intends to hire Environmental Specialist to assist the Project Implementation Group under the Ministry of Transport in the implementation of the PREPARED Project.

The MoT RT hereby invites highly qualified specialists with the experience to take part in the competition.

Main Objectives of the Assignment

The objective of the assignment is to provide support to the PIU of the Ministry of Transport of the Republic of Tajikistan in the implementation of the project, particularly in activities related to the enforcement of the legislation of the Republic of Tajikistan in the field of environmental management, ensuring compliance, as well as adherence to the World Bank’s Environmental and Social Framework (ESF) and other relevant standards, as outlined in the Project’s Environmental and Social Commitment Plan (ESCP).

Qualification requirements for candidates are as follow:

- Higher education in engineering, crop production, environmental protection, occupational health and safety, engineering, or related fields;
- Work experience of at least 5 years and experience in environmental supervision in development projects;
- Excellent communication skills.
- Thorough knowledge and understanding of the Tajikistan environmental administrative framework and policy.
- Good computer skills, including text applications
- Ability to compile reports and synthesize information from various sources
- Fluent in Tajik and Russian languages. Knowledge of English would be advantageous; but is not a requirement.
- The ability to prepare and provide coordinated presentations to different audiences.
- Purposeful, dynamic and able to easily relate to people affected by the project.
- Familiarity with the road sector project would be an advantage.
